1. About Us

www.planitglobal.co.uk (the “**Site**”) is a site operated by PLANit Global Limited (“**PLANit Global**” or “**We**”). We are registered in England and Wales under company number 09353547 and have our registered office at PLANit Global Limited, Technology Centre, Wolverhampton Science Park, Glaisher Drive, Wolverhampton, WV10 9RU. 1. Users of PLANit Global

2. Ability to accept these terms

These Terms of Use applies to all users of, and visitors to, our site. Your use of our site means that you accept and agree to abide by these Terms of Use. If you do not agree to these terms, you must not use our site.

3. Consent

- the Refund Policy (which only relates to Business and its Employees).

If you are under 13, you must have consent to register on our site, and to use the Platform, from a parent, legal guardian or responsible adult.

You must provide a consent confirmation email address when registering.

To abide by our Terms of Use, this needs to be a valid email address of an identifiable person being a parent, legal guardian or responsible adult.

With parental consent and age-verification measures, you will be able to use our site and the platform.

For under 13s, we require verification of your identity from a person with parental responsibility.

4. Use of the site and the platform

The Platform allows individuals and businesses to interact with each other by way of uploading profiles and allows individuals to contact businesses registered on the Platform with an Employer Profile.

We will do our best to assess any possible risks for users (and in particular, for children) from third parties when they use any interactive service provided on our site, and we will decide in each case whether it is appropriate to use moderation of the relevant service (including what kind of moderation to use) in the light of those risks. You also agree:

 - o Any software used in the provision of our site; or
 - o Any equipment or network or software owned or used by any third party.

6. Registration

Only one registration per person is allowed. You must keep your registration information up to date.

You must keep your username and password confidential.

You must not:
